ANNUAL REPORT FOR

2006

This report covers the major activities deliberated and voted on by the Board of Directors and a summary of financial statements in calendar year 2006 and activities for calendar year 2007.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES:

1. At the inaugural meeting, in October 2005, the first major activity was to agree to operate under a draft set of by-laws which included a requirement for a president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer and members-at-large as the makeup of the LTA Board of Directors. The temporary board agreed to name the association The Longmont Tennis Association, to meet on a monthly basis on the 3rd Thursday of the month. Also agreed to at the first meeting was to establish a budget, a checking account, a PO Box and a web site and to finalize a membership form. In addition, actions to pursue liability insurance, article for the Daily Times Call, costs for use of city and school district courts for league, social and tournament play.
2. Other activities on following meetings included PAYPAL as a means for prospective members to pay their annual membership dues etc. The board established an annual membership fee for adults, families, and seniors and to date has 256 members. An LTA LOGO was established for the LTA banner and tennis apparel. An agreement was reached with Instant Imprints to provide LTA engraved T-shirts and other apparel. The board sponsored monthly socials and weekly drop-ins, ladders (mixed and singles) as well as league play at all levels. The board agreed to adopt Carr Park under the City Adopt-a-Park program. The Daily Times Call in their Sporting Life article in the Sports Section provided publicity. Channel 3 also provided daily publicity. The board agreed to fund portable toilets for league play at the high school tennis courts. A calendar of events was established. A financial grant was submitted to the Colorado Tennis Association and was approved for \$500. Several free clinics were sponsored by the LTA. The web site allowed on line membership application, buying tennis apparel, find-a-player and links to other sites. The LTA co-sponsored and assisted in the running of the Front Range Tennis tournament as well as the Boulder County Cup. Over 30 teams were sponsored by the LTA for league play. Quarterly newsletters have been published. A fall banquet and general membership meeting have been established. Winter socials were established for twice per month at the Greeley Workout West tennis facility. The first elections of the LTA BOD will be held this November
